The kick-off meeting of the COMBI “Communication competences for migrants and disadvantaged background learners in bilingual work environments” project was held on the 9th and 10th of November in Leeuwarden (The Netherlands). The project is funded by the DG Education and Culture – Erasmus+ Programme, KA2 Strategic Partnerships for Adult Education. The project involves six partners from five different countries. The other partners are: Fryske Akademy (coordinator, The Netherlands), Elhuyar-Zubize (Spain), Banaiz Bagara elkarte (Spain), Axxell Utbildning AB (Finland), Swansea University (United Kingdom), Centro per lo Sviluppo Creativo “Danilo



Dolci” (Italy). The goals of the COMBI project is to develop innovative and inclusive/systemic practices and methods focused on acquiring communication competences in the languages required in the workplace. It takes into consideration the multilingual reality of European regions. The aim of the method is not to acquire full competences in two or more languages, but to make sure that the regional language is taken into consideration as far as it fulfils language requirements in

the workplace. The COMBI project lasts 36 months. Next project meeting will be held in the Basque Country (Spain) in June 2017 where the first results and intellectual outputs will be discusse

Among the activities of the project:

- * Need Analysis of the target groups' educational needs
- * Development of training modules
- * Pilot training
- * Monitoring the impact of the COMBI method on end-users' attitudes and practices
- * Multiplier events to disseminate the results of the project
